#### *Step 1 Introduction*

- I can demonstrate responsible behaviors when interacting with others.
- I can demonstrate the best ways to solve social problems.

#### *Step 2 Activity*

- Students will be given a scenario and their job is to demonstrate an action that would show how to respond kindly/appropriately.
- Students will work on locomotor skills between scenarios.

#### *Step 3 Closure*

- Screen On/Screen Off - keep your screen on if you feel better able to handle interactions with others, including solving problems. Turn your screen off if you don't.

### Assessments

- Pre-Assessment: Screen On/Screen Off - keep your screen on if you feel confident in your ability to handle interactions with others, including solving problems. Turn your screen off if you don't.
- Post-Assessment: Screen On/Screen Off - keep your screen on if you feel better able to handle interactions with others, including solving problems. Turn your screen off if you don't.
