Grade 4 Sample Lesson Plan: Our Community's Health

Objectives/Goals

• Students will analyze a community health issue and develop and promote possible solutions.

Materials

- Internet access
- A variety of Internet, print and audiovisual resources on various health conditions that affect a community.

Procedure

Step 1

Community Health Problems

- Provide students with a list of health outcomes (e.g., diabetes, cancer, heart disease, that occur in communities that lack opportunities for physical activity oand access to healthy foods.
- Break students into small study groups organized around one health area of interest.
- Help them access information, posters, brochures, videos on the topic from various sources including the KidsHealth.org site (https://kidshealth.org/en/kids) and local hospital and health department sites.
- As a group, they need to identify three possible causes or contributors to the health problem
 and create a skit, poster, jingle to describe the health problem, its causes and possible solutions
 to address or reduce the contributors or otherwise prevent the health problems.

Step 2

Community Volunteering

- After the students present their solutions, applaud their effort in working together
 to address a community health issue. Remind them that there are a number of ways
 they can become involved in making their community a better place, including
 participating as a volunteer in local walks to raise awareness and money for
 prevention, research, and treatment of health conditions (e.g. Heart, Cancer,
 Diabetes, Leukemia and Lymphoma, Alzheimers, local children's hospitals).
- Organize a Jump Rope for the Heart Event

- Give the students information on local volunteer opportunities including health walks and encourage them to sign up to participate with their families.

Assessment Idea

• Evaluate student participation in research project.
