Step 1 Introduction

- What are emergencies that could happen at school?
- What things could happen at school that aren't an emergency?

Step 2 Activity

- Discuss with your class the difference between emergencies and non-emergencies.
- Activity: Safety Walk
 - Follow your teacher around the school and identify things that are used or places to go in the event of an emergency and things that are used or places to go for non-emergency situations.
 - Review any emergency procedures you already have in place.

Step 3 Closure

- Do you know the difference between an emergency and non-emergency?

Assessments

- Pre: Questions will introduce topic, engage learners, and access prior knowledge
- Post: The activity will demonstrate student understanding of material covered during class. Teacher will observe student choices to determine level of understanding.

Extensions/Connections/Applications

- The teacher can have more discussion as desired with students throughout the lesson.
- The teacher can have students write things down on a clipboard that they see on the walk
